The church is 125 years old this year and was built as a Congregational Church , then in 1972 joined with the Presbyterians and became a United Reformed Church . In 1995 it was bought with donations from the Catholic parishioners of Our Lady Star of the Sea.

There will be a small exhibition about the courageous Claud Castleton who received the VC medal in World War 1. There will also be an exhibition about the beautiful Art Nouveau Stained Glass Windows and how stained glass is made.
